I. CALL TO ORDER

The Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) met at the hour of 2:00 p.m., with the following members present: Chief Deputy Darren Gantz, representing Commissioner Kelly Dunkerley, Chief Deputy Mark Vancuren, representing Commissioner Lonnie Sims and Commissioner Stan Sallee. II. ROLL CALL

III. ACTION ITEMS

- A. Resolution - (Tulsa Emergency Management) - Proclaiming that an extreme fire danger exists in Tulsa County, and that an immediate burn ban exists in Tulsa County. This situation has been verified by a documented concurrence of the majority of the County's municipal and rural fire chiefs or their delegates, and is effective immediately for a period not to exceed 7 days (Clerk's Misc. File No. 20261861)

The Resolution was amended to be in effect through Tuesday, September 8. Due to the persistent hot, dry conditions, a subsequent resolution will be added to 9/8/2026 agenda, effective through 9/21/2026 eliminating the need for a special meeting to be held to extend the ban. Motion made by Darren Gantz, seconded by Mark Vancuren, to adopt a resolution authorizing the burn ban, as amended. Upon roll call, Yes - Darren Gantz, Mark Vancuren, Stan Sallee. No - None. Abstain - None. Motion carried.
