I. CALL TO ORDER

- A. Resolution - (TC Emergency Management) - declaring an extreme fire danger exists, and that an immediate burn ban is needed in Tulsa County, effective immediately for a period not to exceed seven days. If extreme fire danger conditions persist, subsequent resolutions may be considered for passage. The burn ban may be removed at any time during the seven-day period in the same method by which it was approved

Bill Smiley, Emergency Management Director, advised that the area Fire Chiefs concur that with the expected rain later this week and the greening up that has taken place, a burn ban is not necessary at this time.
