I. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Dunkeley called the BOCC Management Conference to order at 9:33 a.m.

IV. ACTION ITEMS

- A. Tulsa County Planning Discussion – Chief Deputy Michael Craddock / Douglas Wilson, Assistant District Attorney, Civil Division

Michael Craddock brought up for discussion the creation of a Tulsa County Planning Department. Rich Brierre presented statutory options available for the Board of County Commissioners to consider regarding establishing a planning department. Craddock recommended a task force be formed to further discuss options.

B. Office of Government Efficiency and Transparency Update — David Tackett, Manager
David Tackett provided a legislative update on state priorities and federal advocacy efforts. Tackett outlined the legislative effort that has occurred and outlined next steps for committee engagement and sustained delegation support.

- C. Tulsa County Parks, 2026 Objectives and Key Results — Matt Hancock, Director of Parks and Recreation

Matt Hancock provided an overview of the 2026 Objectives and Key Results for Tulsa County Parks and Recreation. He highlighted that the department is moving from "managing facilities" to operating a high-performing public benefit system that is grounded in mission, driven by data, and elevated by service excellence. Hancock shared the strategic priorities for the department and stated that there will be long-term master plans for each priority.
