IV. Approval of Minutes

V. Reports, Recommendations and Possible Action

A. Sales Tax Receipts & Disbursements – Aaron Wiedman, Budget Office

The Tulsa County Clerk's Budget Office provided written reports which were reviewed by Aaron Wiedman. Wiedman explained sales tax revenues increased year over year, 4.7 percent; and 7.1 percent year over two years. The use tax revenues have been trending downward. Criminal Justice Authority agreed to use the fund balance of \$3,140,665.00 for the jail budget. Commissary Fund 700 contributed a total of \$2,913,195.00 to the jail operating expenses.

B. Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Report – Stacie Holloway, Jail Administrator

Stacie Holloway provided an update on the Sheriff's report; noting the inmate population, it has remained consistent in the upper 1,400s, with a detailed breakdown by inmate type. The Sheriff's office is also collaborating with a partner organization to develop an inmate garden, with a memorandum of understanding (MOU) in place that assigns the responsibility for dirt work and fence relocation. Ongoing discussions with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMH) are also taking place to secure a dedicated pod in the jail for competency restoration, with ODMH expressing strong interest in the initiative.
