Disaster Emergency Declaration for Tulsa County - with all the powers and responsibilities thereto as provided in the Oklahoma State Statutes, acting on behalf of the citizens of Tulsa County, do hereby declare that a state of emergency exists within Tulsa County, and that Tulsa County is a disaster area within the destination provided in the Oklahoma Emergency Management Act of 2003 as amended, and its citizens are entitled to aid, relief, and assistance following the severe weather event of June 18, 2023 and do hereby direct the implementation of the Tulsa County Emergency Operations Plan. THIS PROCLAMATION SHALL EXPIRE AFTER EIGHT (8) DAYS UNLESS OTHERWISE EXTENDED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TULSA
