MINUTES
Monday, April 28, 2025

I. Call to Order

Chairman Dan Witham called the Tulsa County Criminal Justice Authority (TCCJA) Sales Tax Committee to order at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in Room 132, of the Tulsa County HQ Building, 218 East 6 Street, Tulsa, OK. The following business was transacted:

III. Approval of Minutes

A. Minutes of Meeting - January 27, 2025

Witham called for a discussion of the minutes. None ensued.

Motion made by Todd Pals, seconded by Joe Shelton, to accept and file the minutes of January 27, 2025.

IV. Reports, Recommendations and Possible Action

A. Sales Tax Receipts & Disbursements – Aaron Wiedman, Budget Office

The Tulsa County Clerk's Budget Office provided written reports which were reviewed by Aaron Wiedman. He noted that sales tax revenues had increased 3% year over last year and 3% year over two years ago and the budget department will continue to watch sales tax collections. CJA Fund 700 reflects total revenues of \$9,154,451, and total expenses of \$9,154,875. County Contribution Fund 365 reflects total revenues of \$4,470,418, and total expenses of \$4,663,422. He noted revenues from U.S. Marshall's housing, Other inmates housing, and the sales tax and use tax continued to be strong sources of revenue. Commissary Fund 370 reflects total revenues of \$636,791, total expenses of \$716,916, and a total of \$309,352 has been contributed to the jail operating expense fund. The Combined Statement with Detail reflects total revenues of \$14,261,660, and total expenses of \$14,535,213.

B. Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Report – Stacie Holloway, Jail Administrator

The Sheriff's Office provided a written report. Assistant Jail Administrator Berry provided an oral report for the Authority, noting the inmate count for the day was 1,559 on April 28, 2025, and has remained steady, as has the count for those held on felony charges, misdemeanor charges, federal charges, those held on writs or holds from other agencies, and the City of Tulsa inmates. Cherokee Nation is still in negotiation with Tulsa County for a future partnership. Berry fielded questions regarding ICE and the effects of the new laws being passed at the Capitol. He commented on the increase in inmates but noted that the county facility remains a 72-hour holding facility. They are still within staffing limits, they are feeling the stress of the extra work load. Stacy Pratt asked if the population coming from ICE is local or statewide. Berry confirmed it is from the state and surrounding states, depending on the need. The majority of the Federal ICE population is still being transferred through Oklahoma City. Justin Little requested more specific statistics. Barry assured us there would be more specifics at the next meeting. The Sheriff's Office is dealing with IT issues at the moment.

C. STOC Representation for the TCCJA Meetings May 28, 2025, June 25, 2025, and July 23, 2026, which are held Wednesdays at 8:30 a.m.

TCCJA STOC representation for the meetings are: Dan Witham for the May 28, 2025 meeting; Dr. Tyler for the June 25, 2025 meeting; and Justin Little for the July 23, 2025 meeting.

V. New Business

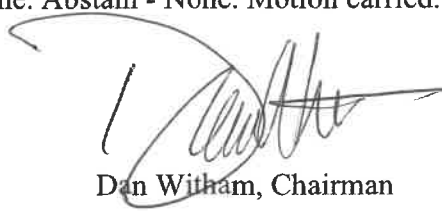
