MINUTES
Monday, July 28, 2025

I. Call to Order

The Tulsa County Criminal Justice Authority Sales Tax Overview (TCCJA STOC) met at the hour of 2:00 p.m. in the 2nd Floor Conference Room of the David L. Moss Criminal Justice Center, 300 North Denver Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma, on January 27, 2025. The following business was transacted:

II. Roll Call

Chairman Dan Witham requested roll to be called. Members present: Joyce Calvert, Edward Huff, Justin Little, Richard Oltmann, Todd Pals, Stacy Pratt, Pam Vreeland, Dr. Donald Tyler, and Dan Witham. Members absent: Mike Lester, Paul McCurtain, Joe Shelton, and Richard Waite. Others present included Aaron Wiedman, Tulsa County Clerk's Budget Office; Stacie Holloway, Jail Administrator, Tamara Stanley and Jessi Phillips, Sheriff's Office; and Recording Secretary Sherry Langston.

III. Approval of Minutes

A. Minutes of April 28, 2025

Witham called for a discussion of the minutes, none ensued.

Motion made by Stacy Pratt, seconded by Dr. Donald Tyler, to accept and file the minutes of April 28, 2025. IV. Reports, Recommendations and Possible Action

A. Sales Tax Receipts & Disbursements – Aaron Wiedman, Budget Office

The Tulsa County Clerk's Budget Office provided written reports which were reviewed by Aaron Wiedman. Wiedman reviewed the quarterly report for the period ending June 30, 2025. For the end of the fiscal year, sales tax collections were up for seven months and down for five months. He explained he has discussed the state of revenues versus the expenses extensively with the Tulsa County Criminal Justice Authority (TCCJA) Trustees and will continue to monitor the budget. He explained the fiscal year-end process. Wiedman noted the revenues from the Department of Corrections, US Marshals, ICE, and Other Inmates continued to be a steady revenue stream. Commissary Fund 370 contributed a total of \$1,084,802 to the jail operating expense fund. He explained the TCCJA trustees approved using the fund balance to balance the budget. Tamara Stanley, Sheriff's Office, explained there have been some challenges with billing ability during the transition from IMAX to 365.

B. Tulsa County Sheriff's Office Report – Stacie Holloway, Jail Administrator

Jail Administrator Stacie Holloway provided an oral jail report. The jail population has stayed steady in the 1,200 range; there have been some days when it fluctuated between 1,600-1,700 due to the larger ICE population. The Cherokee Nation contract has been finalized and approved. The Sheriff's Office does not have a long-term contract with ICE. The federal housing rate is being renegotiated from \$75 per day to between \$126-130 per day. In response to Committee Member Calvert's question concerning the rate the Sovereign Nations pay, it was explained that they pay the same rate as the US Marshall's rate.

C. Calendar of Meetings 2026

Witham called for a discussion of the Calendar of Meetings 2026, none ensued.

Motion made by Dr. Donald Tyler, seconded by Justin Little, to accept and file the Calendar of Meetings 2026.

V. New Business

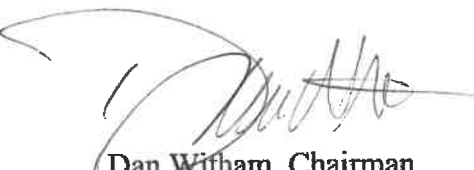
